### Strengths of SEND in school -improvements made

- Pupils, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND), are fully prepared for their next stage of education. OFSTED March 2022
- Interventions and QFT are having notable impact.
- All pupils have an Individual learning plan that is recorded on our Provision Mapping tool, these are reviewed half termly and impact of provision/interventions are reviewed
- Adaptive teaching is skilfully planned to ensure all learners are having their SEND needs matched
- Reading is prioritised for all children.
- Our most vulnerable learners have impactful nurture and pastoral support sessions
- The school is taking part in trauma informed training to become an accredited TIS school

### To improve SEND our KEY priorities are ...

- To further develop metacognitive strategies for all pupils with additional needs
- To ensure all interventions result in sustained and rapid progress
- To develop all LSAs as highly effective intervention leads
- To continue to cease EHCPs where appropriate and where pupils are meeting long term targets
- To continue to be a centre of excellence for all ACE schools in terms of provisions and support for learners with SEND
